A Quick Overview § - Section 1A:

Terminology § - Section 1B:

- "client", "user", "you" and "your":
 refers to you, the individual who may be accessing this website.
- "Me", "Ourselves", "We", "Our" and "Us": refers to me (Samara Crawford-Hunt), any of my business partners and the individuals we choose to employ.
- "Our website", "My website", "This website" and "The website": refers to the website located at: https://thehunt.uk and any of it's associated subdomains.
- "3rd party": refers to organizations or businesses that are completely external to my own.

Summary § - Section 1C:

In order for this website to function it is necessary for it to collect, process, send and sometimes store data. Some of this data may be information you personally choose to provide or some may be information used by the website automatically to provide a smooth user experience, but whatever the case it is important that you, the user, understand how data is processed during the usage of this website. That is what this document aims to clarify.

Your Data And What We Use It For

Users Under The Age Of 18 § - Section 2A:

Our Service does not address anyone under the age of 18.

We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 18. If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your child has provided us with personal data, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected personal data from a child without verification of parental consent, we take steps to remove that information from our servers.

What Personal Data Do We Collect?

§ - Section 2B:

This website collects several different types of data while in use. The Types Of Cookies Used On Our Website

§ - Section 2D:

- Session Cookies. We use session cookies to operate the website.
- Preference Cookies. We use preference cookies to remember your preferences and various settings.
- Security Cookies. We use security cookies to enhance the security of this website.

What Your Data Is Used For

- To provide and maintain the website
- To notify you about changes to the website
- To allow you to participate in interactive features of the website when you choose to do so

How Your Data Is Handled

Transfer Of Data
